To All exhibitors and participants:

We have received calls and emails regarding the upcoming shows: April 9-13, 2020 at Chilliwack Heritage Park in Chilliwack BC. We have all seen the media and social media reports.

The Government of British Columbia, via the provincial Health officials, have announced no gatherings of people over 250 are permitted at this time. This is due to the COVID19 issue. We were advised by the operators of the venue a short while ago that we would not be permitted to host the event as planned.

In short, the All Breed Shows shows above, plus all Specialty clubs with conformation, obedience and rally are cancelled.

Refunds will begin to be issued beginning Saturday. It will take a while. They are processed by Moneris and will appear on your statement 3-5 business days after processing. This includes the all breed show and specialties. For All Breed entries placed with the past few days that have a reference number of 36430** or higher these entries have not been processed, nor will they be. The specialty entries are processed separately. **Bottom left of PDF—last five digits.

We apologize for this, but reality and perceptions are changing rapidly here. We are looking at future options, but nothing will be decided in the next while until things normalize.
